Find out how to apply

Check if you can apply for funding from the International Fund for Fishing Safety if your organisation has a project which will help commercial fishers.

To be eligible, your project must meet the following criteria:

- » Be for fishers: The project must involve and benefit wild capture commercial fishers
- » Focus on safety and health: For fishers and the vessels they work on
- » Not for profit: The project must operate on a not-for-profit or charitable basis
- » Follow global standards: Match the International standards in fishing of STCW-F or ILO C188 or the Cape Town Agreement
- » Long-term impact: Show lasting benefits and the potential to be applied in other fisheries/countries
- » Share knowledge: Share lessons learned with fishers worldwide
